The Mirowitz Investment Club is a new and exciting opportunity for Middle School students to explore the real-world of Wall Street! Students will learn the concepts of:

- Stocks
- Bonds
- Financial return
- Risk
- Company research and analysis
- Asset allocation

Students will work as a team to invest real money (that has been donated to the school) and a small amount of their own money (\$25). Money will be placed into a single account used for purchasing stocks decided on by the club members. These student-contributed funds will be returned plus any gains or less any losses the investments realize. The gains from the funds will be split between the school (tzedakah!) and fun events for club members.

Sessions will be taught by various financial/investment professionals in our community. Students will receive materials, pre-reads and handouts to help enrich discussions and debates (ex: Apple vs. Nike stock). Students will also be exposed to professionals in different areas of finance and will attend one field trip to an investment company.
