Class 1: What's in the Doctor's Bag?

Students get up and moving to learn how air enters and exits the body.

Class 4: Digesting Digestion!

Through an interactive exercise, students learn what happens when their bodies digest food.

Class 5: Is There a Surgeon in the House?

A face mask and gloves will make students feel like real surgeons as they learn to suture and tie knots!

Class 6: First Aid!

Students will learn how to respond when first aid is needed and be able to identify items needed in a first aid kit.

Class 7: The Wonderful Brain!

Students will learn about the brain and how it works. They will also build a model of the brain.

Students will gain an understanding of what gas is and why we burp and belch.

Class 9: Your Spine is Fine!

Students will be able to explain what the spine does and identify the different levels of the spine.

Class 10: Pharmacy!

Students will be able to explain what a prescription is and what information it must contain. Students will gain an understanding of how pharmacists dispense prescriptions.

Class 11: The Exciting Eye!

Students will create a model of the eye, learn about the parts of the eye and how it reacts to light.
