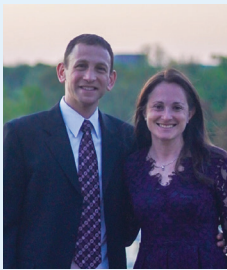
About Saul Mirowitz Jewish Community School
